Responsibilities

- **Documentation:** You will carefully document the work carried out and the results of inspections and checks in accordance with the specifications.

- **Deviations:** If deviations from the specifications and standards occur, you report these to the relevant departments.

- Many years of experience with the aforementioned aircraft type and good knowledge of European and national aviation law

- Requirements for a valid background check in accordance with LuftSiG § 7
